### Better for you

- Save more than £600. Disposables can cost you over £1000 but a full set of real nappies can cost you £200 or less.



### Better for your baby

- Real nappies are a healthy natural choice for your baby's young delicate skin.
- Why take the risk of exposure to absorbent chemical gels in disposable nappies when there is an easy alternative.
- Real nappies are effective, and keep your baby comfortable and hygienic.
- Nappy rash is no more likely in washable nappies.



### Best for everyone

- A massive 8,000,000 nappies are thrown away in Britain every day.
- They take 100's of years to decompose, most end up on landfill sites.
- Bradford's nappies cost Bradford Council around £800,000 a year to dispose of. Money that could be better spent.
- Every time you use a re-usable nappy you are preserving your baby's future.

At last here is an important environmental issue where your choices make a real impact.

### What can you do?

Getting started is easy. Buy some real nappies, you just need 20 – 24 nappies and 4 to 6 wraps for a new baby, less if your baby is older or if you can wash every day. Buying your own gives you more choice and greater savings, a laundry service, scores high on convenience with no extra washing.
